Cox: College of Agriculture, Food and Environment (CAFE) Dean 1,507 staff in CAFE, little over 1,000 are not in Lexington Very happy that the legislature granted a much-needed adjustment for salary of our extension agents in the last session Each county has an extension office and board. The staff and agents that work in those counties also live in those communities Buildings for extension offices are paid for by the counties; therefore, they have a lot of appropriate opinions about how we should organize and what we should do They did a needs assessment across all 120 counties and the main need is substance abuse. They are establishing a lot of partnerships with other health care colleges UK was formed in 1865 from the land grant In 2020, President Capilouto gave N. 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| position is to try to bring more expertise to the communities and counties from other colleges They are establishing partnerships with the Colleges of Dentistry, Design, Fine Arts, Nursing, and Pharmacy; Barnstable Brown Diabetes Center, and UK HealthCare. Jeff Fugate, from the College of Design, is their first extension professor and he is working on the built environment and communities The hope is to expand what the University can do for a community. They are also working with enrollment management to try to bring more students and recruit them to UK 4-H M. They were sent to the BOT for their first reading and approval; they will go next week for the second reading Approvals during BOT meeting: GR 1: name of some colleges, university vision statement to be consistent with the most recent strategic plan, updated some titles of where operations had changed, eliminated a section on solicitation of funds because no one could remember when or why that was used, and then they updated all of the GR to our new format which includes the locked U and K at the header and some other formatting things to make them look more modern GR II: only change was removing the title of Chief Executive and made it more general to be consistent with the others GR IV: changes in the most recent reorganization with Vice President for Student Success and the Provost, add the Dean of Lewis Honors College, some titles changed, e.g., College of Agriculture, Food and Environment GR XI: in Student Affairs the changes pertained to titles and some document titles have changed related to the student code |
