2. President's Report	 79% vaccination rate across campus as of September 4, 2021 101 active cases of COVID-19 among students, 169 in quarantine, 5% in isolation 2.77% positivity rate among 8,000 unvaccinated students DEI: Dr. Albert was announced as Vice President of Diversity, will begin full time September 27, 2021 Mandating vaccines for the university: continuing conversations around this topic. We will continue to look at other recommendations. Weekly testing is required for unvaccinated employees and students Resolution on flexible work arrangements: he can offer suggestions and recommendations if needed R.Story: feels a mandate would be good to get the other 20% on board with the university K.Lambert: can we have the COVID-19 dashboard updated more than once per week and when should we know the criteria for people that do not follow the guidelines for testing? E.Monday said he would let his team know to bump that to twice a week. Hope to have information out by next week regarding the criteria T.Keys: the positivity rate in KY is more than 14% now and hospitals are full. Will things change on campus since these numbers are so high? E.Monday: the university concentrates on the positivity rates for our campus for now 	



	 L.Harned: in regards to the booster vaccine/third shot, will UK offer that to UK employees? E.Monday states that it is a strong possibility that we will offer it and will look at locations to offer those R.Gardner: what supporting documents are needed when there is a religious or medical reason not to get the vaccine? E.Monday said it will be shared online in the coming days L.Wood: how are the employee self-reporting tool and the employee testing site? E.Monday said self-reporting is robust but the testing is not going as smooth and it is a concern. We have plenty of capacity E.Kostrub: is there a lag in the contact tracing? She has heard that some people that have self-reported have not heard back. E.Monday said he is not aware of any lag, but if the person did not report at UK, then we do not have control of any other contact tracing mechanisms. Encourage people to self-report immediately through Health Corps or call 218-SAFE Employee testing locations: K-Lair, Scott Street Parking Lot, Student Center, Kroger Field Blue Lot, Student Center Blue Box, College Way, President's Pavilion, and Employee Health
