	 Expanding UK HealthCare's capacity to care for our community, our people, and our talent Growing as an academic health system to meet the health needs of Kentucky We heard a lot about the staff and our families having access to UK HealthCare. Simply put: We have an access problem. Not only for our community but for UK staff and their families I am guessing most people here are aware of Turfland, Team Blue (former Kentucky Clinic South), and Fountain Court Board approved adding 4 more locations Hamburg – primary care, urgent care, adult and pediatrics Madison County – Primary care, orthopedics, rotating specialties
	 Underserved portion of Fayette County – TBD Frankfort – primary care, urgent care, orthopedics, neurology, gastroenterology, urology As part of that, the Board approved a \$30 million design phase for a new medical facility in Hamburg Board also approved several projects that will enhance, expand and renovate our current facility care facility Renovate Mother Baby and Labor and Delivery Unit

This is shelled space adjacent to our existing operating rooms We also approved the design phase to expand the patient care facility. Accepted the largest gift in UK history - \$34.5 million from Karen and Stanley Pigman, naming it the Pigman College of Engineering Made a change to retirement contributions 403B will be mandatory from those 25-29 for all new hires on July 1, 2023 Mandatory for all new hires of any age July 1, 2024
