Call to Order/Approve May Minutes	 Meeting called to order at 1:07 p.m. May minutes approved unanimously 	
2. President's Report	 Staff Appreciation Day was a huge success and he thanks all of us FY24 Budget Increase tuition fees for FY24: 2.75% for the resident rate and 3.5% increase for non-resident Asking for approval of the capital operating budget for FY24: \$6.8 billion. 21% increase from FY23 to FY24 Salary increase: maximum flexibility for the distribution of funds Modest increase in employee health benefit costs Carry over vacation leave for staff until September 30 M. Thompson: asked Dr. Monday about the differences in faculty and staff salaries and how faculty receive higher percentages in raises than the staff does. She also shared another concern from the same constituent about the concern that the upper leadership receives greater salary increases than staff and they do not see that the "UK Way" is not going to change because it hasn't in the many years they have been working here M. Lucy: please reach out to Dr. Monday after the July raises have been communicated to see the distribution for campus employees and in October talk to the Healthcare employees	

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	 R. Earls is concerned about the healthcare increases for the employees and we should be trying to keep our employees going to UK doctors and hospitals and not raising our costs A. Anders: any updates on the CIO of Healthcare position – Interim CIO started recently and his name is Michael O'Rourke T. Keys: he was not able to get over 20% salary increase when he received his promotion but if he was an outside person coming into UK, he would have gotten that extra increase. Dr. Monday said his supervisor should have filled out the exception form and he asks for him to go back and ask for that S. Sorrell: asking for an update on the re-surfacing of State Street and Press Avenue
	 J. Sumner: we should train the hiring officials more about the rules, overloads, and exceptions with hiring A. Anders: draft site is still up and searchable on the UK Search engine and they aren't seeing the updated/correct information. J. Sumner said he could fix it because his dept. controls the search
