Call to Order/Approve Minutes	The meeting was called to order at 1:08 pm. The minutes from the July meeting were approved by a motion from Senator Brewer, a second by Senator Keys and a vote from the body.	
2. President's Report	 The University of Kentucky is committed to educating more Kentuckians and building a great workforce for Kentucky. Thank you did to prepare us to welcome 35,000 students. We are going to graduate more students in a shorter amount of time. Our improvements in student success is one of the things he is most proud of because no one unit, no one person, no one department, and no one College can do that. It takes everybody, President Capilouto is pleased and thankful for our understanding, dialogue and support of the changes we are making in our shared governance. The Senate recommended members to serve on the 5 work groups to revise our administrative regulations. The groups are finance, administration, research, constitutional and civil rights, faculty academic and student affairs. Dr. Monday, in conversations with our Chair, shared how we were already working to hardwire our new governing regulations. The University is going to make certain the advice we give on everything from infrastructure, compensation, career path is heard. More and more students want to make the University their first choice. These are made up of first generation, underrepresented background or low-income students. Those that came before had an incredible vision to no Kentuckian should ever have to leave home, no matter how sick they are, no matter how complicated the care needed. This also did not mean that they needed to travel to Lexington for care, instead receiving care in their own communities such as Ashland with King's Daughter's Hospital. King's Daughter's has an approximate \$200,000,000 construction site where they are going to have a modern emergency department, which was made possible by our partnership. We are building a new sub-specialty ambulatory facility that largely will treat those facing cancer but will also emphasize spinal treatments and sub-acute specialty areas. In the last two years, we have turned away 10,000 transfers but thanks to our help we have been able to

	Blanding/Kirwin towers once stood, we have started construction on a new residence hall.
	 We have a healthy budget, and he is appreciative of Staff Trustee Melanson and the other Board of Trustees members asking the hard questions about our budget and keeping us in a sound financial position. Benefits are being studied to fit our family's needs. They have invested 18,000,000 in the salary increase pool and it looks as though it can be done again next year. The new Health Education Building will allow us to bring four health colleges into one space which will allow for interdisciplinary training. Thanks to the State and the Gatton Foundation's contribution, our Agriculture campus is being renewed. We will have a new Research Building and in partnership with the Federal Government, thanks to Senate Leader McConnell, we are building additional laboratories. One of the original Ag buildings is being renovated
3. Trustee Report	Trustee Melanson introduced himself as the staff representative on the Board of Trustees representing all of us and the campus. For all the new Senators, the Board consists of 20 members, 16 are appointed by the Governor and they have 6-year rotating terms. There are 4 elected individuals: a student government representative (1 year term), 2 faculty representatives (3-year term) and one staff representative (3-year term). They meet six times per year. The meetings are open to the public and are held at the Gatton Student Center. There are a series of committees. The next meeting is in mid-September.
4. Guest Speakers:	 Dr. Carrie Davidson is the Fitness Manager for UK Health & Wellness and is here on behalf of H.R. WorkLife and Wellbeing. We have registered dieticians on our staff. We also have exercise physiologists, health coaches, mental health therapists, Work/life specialists. You can go to your Health & Wellness dashboard and schedule a consult by Zoom, in person, phone or email. They can be done in a variety of ways. The dieticians have programming around nutrition, intuitive eating, moving well, CSA vouchers and memberships. Our health coaches do tobacco cessation. We receive five mental health visits every calendar year. This does not go on your record, and we have 4 in-house therapists. There are several online tools regarding personal finance. There are 121 different programs listed on their website. There are several calming spaces around campus. These rooms are cleaned daily. They can be used by students or employees. It is a resting place. They also can provide a worksheet where you can create your own calming space in your unit. There are two fitness centers on campus, Seaton Center and one on Export
	 There are two littless centers on campus, Seaton Center and one on Export Street. There is a pool at the Lancaster Aquatic Center. UK has lots of employee discounts which can be found on the HR Benefits website.
